Fish Report by Chris Bailey

As of March 28, 2018

Coastal Water Temps have dropped and remain cool along the coast and local islands (Upper 50's) due to recent weather patterns. Forecast calls for improving weather and warmer days. Expect to see the water temps improve throughout April. Limited Fishing Reports are available with most boats focusing on rockfish. Looking for improved conditions and fishing during the month of April.

March 31st Full Moon – building tides for the next few days. Grunion run March 31st to April 3rd.

Dana Point – Barn Kelp: Calico Bass along the kelp line starting to bite.

Newport Artificial Reef and Pipe: Has had some descent bass fishing on plastic and jigs.

Horseshoe and Izor: Larger Sandbass biting plastics and jigs.

Catalina: Limited reports coming in from Catalina, but a couple boats fishing the backside. Should start seeing Yellowtail

and Calicos biting near the island.

San Diego / La Jolla: Limited reports coming in from San Diego, slow bite on Yellowtail.

Coronados: Yellowtail biting the Surface Iron and Yo-Yo jigs.

Bluefin Tuna: Rumors and limited reports of Bluefin Tuna. Smaller grade below 425 and larger models caught 160 Miles of SD and moving north. Hopefully with the improving weather and water temps they will reach the SoCal waters soon.


