

## Fish Report by Scott Kingsmill

White Seabass Tournament was slim pickings for those that tried. There are big ones around (40-60 pounders) but they're not easy to boat unless your name is Geoff Heldoorn or Chris Bailey. Before the tournament they both got new club WSB records. With not many days left, Jim Kingsmill & Wild Bill crew decided to fish heavier line even though it was a line class tournament. The prior weekend we fished Newport Reef #1 but only caught the bottom and lost an anchor. The next week we fished Crystal Cove area on Saturday. We think we hooked a thresher that broke us off earlier that morning. Stuck it out for a long slow day but Jim hooked a small 8.6 lbs. WSB on 50# in the afternoon for the only one of the tournament. Chris Bailey was going for it and fished the last day, Sunday, at La Jolla. He hooked 2 WSB on 4# test but was unable to bring them in.


The 3B tournament on Sunday, June 23rd had 5 boats go to Catalina and a couple stay local. As usual the winning fishes came from Catalina. Catalina was a zoo with boats everywhere mostly chasing yellowtail. Rodger Healy had a guest, Craig Jacobs, beat everyone this year catching all 3 fish and getting the most points. Then to top it off Craig caught a 10 lbs. halibut in shallow water near the quarry area on a fly lined sardine. Most boats fished the Eastend to Hen Rock on the front side. Chris Bailey took 1st for DAC member with a bass & bonito. Rodger Healy 2nd & Terry Keenan 3rd. Wild Bill went all the way to Salta Verde on the backside catching lots of calico's and barracuda but all were too short except Dave Herrera's just legal calico. Extended tournament hours definitely helped but 2pm came around fast & we all ran home for the fuel dock. Then we all got together at DPYC to tell our fish stories.





#### Fish Report

It looks like the last report on the Bluefin Tuna shows them up around the 43 mile bank on Monday, June 24th. There are scattered yellowtail all around Catalina. When we fished Salta Verde on Sunday we could see a big fleet of boats at China Point fishing yellowtail. They must have been right up next to the fish closer area. Pay attention to where you're at so you don't get a ticket. Fish & Game was out there Sunday too.



#### Fish Scale

If you're weighing in for a tournament or a club record ask for the DAC scale in the black case. It weighs 1/10th of pound increments. The red Dana Fuel Dock scale weighs in 2/10th's of pound increments so not quite as accurate. Also be careful with DAC scales cord. It was recently broken when a non-member weighed in a thresher shark. Johnny at the fuel dock was nice enough to have it repaired for us.


