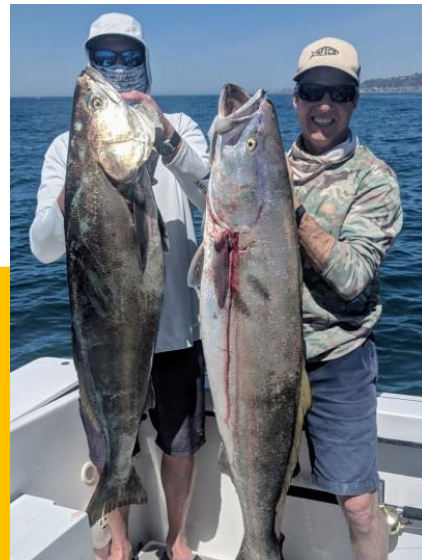

Currently rough seas hampering the fishing. Last report 5/19 there were 50-80 lb. bluefin tuna 60 miles below Point Loma, Northeast of the 425 knuckle. Yellowtail & bonito at the Coronado Islands.

There was a good bite on yellowtail on frontside of Catalina about a week ago. There were also reports of legal size barracuda on East End of Catalina and around back to Salta Verde. Hopefully they'll be around for our 3-B Tournament on Sunday, June 23rd.



DAC 3B TOURNAMENT & *BBQ*

LINES IN: 6:30 a.m. -- LINES OUT: 1:00 p.m. -- WEIGH IN: 1:00 p.m. - 3:00 p.m.

RULES:

Bonito, Bass, and Barracuda only

Each angler may weigh one of each species for a total weight

All DAC and IGFA angling rules apply

All fish must be weighed in at the Dana Point Fuel Dock by 3 p.m.

Note: BASS species entries may be represented by a calico, sand, or spotted bay bass only.

*****ALL COMPETITORS (including guests and juniors) MUST CALL TOURNAMENT BOAT AT THE DANA PT. HARBOR ENTRANCE (RED BUOY) ON CHANNEL 19 BETWEEN 6:15 a.m. & 6:30 a.m. for the "Shotgun Start". Even if you start late, check-in is REQUIRED prior to fishing to qualify for this Tournament!*****

SCORING: HEAVIEST TOTAL SCORE OF CATCH WINS!

1 Point per pound

2 Bonus Points for Live Release of Calico Bass

5 Bonus Points for a "Slam" if the angler submits one fish from each of the three categories for score (i.e. one Bonita, one Bass, and one Barracuda).

"Slam" Bonus Points do not apply to Top All Around Boat Award.

TIE BREAKER: In the event of a tie, the following criteria will be used to determine a winner, in this order: whether or not a slam was recorded, then First to Weigh-In.

AWARDS:

ADULTS: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place

JUNIORS: 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place

ADULT/JUNIOR GUESTS: 1st place only

Top Boat will be Awarded
