### ARTIFICIAL BAITS ONLY- Only artificial baits allowed

"GULP" baits will be allowed - Any artificial bait is allowed - No live or frozen bait of any kind may be attached to the lure or hook - Scents such as Pro-Cure, Hot Sauce, etc. are allowed

Albacore, Barracuda, Bass, Bonita, Dorado, Halibut, Marlin, Salmon, Swordfish, Tuna, White Seabass, & Yellowtail ONLY

#### **NO LINE MAXIMUM**

All fish MUST be caught according to DAC & IGFA rules All weight slips must be submitted via the website within 10 days of your catch. Only ONE ENTRY per angler

#### WEIGH STATION LOCATED AT THE DANA POINT FUEL DOCK

#### **HEAVIEST FISH WINS!**

1 Point per pound (lb.) 1st Tie Breaker - Earliest Fish 2 Bonus Points for Live Release of Calico Bass 2nd Tie Breaker - Time On Fish after weighing, per DAC rules

#### **PRIZES**
