Fish Report


As you know, stormy weather has been going on for a while this winter so be careful when you finally get out fishing again. There is tons of debris in the ocean. On a recent drive (car) over to the Dana Point Fuel Dock I could see the tree branches on the beach and floating in the waves at Doheny.

Remember to get your 2019 fishing license if you haven't already. You can purchase them online at https://www.wildlife.ca.gov/licensing/online-sales.

Here is the website for the 2018-2019 California Fishing Regulations: http://www.eregulations.com/wp-content/uploads/2018/02/18CASW_LR3.pdf. Some notable areas to read up on: Pages 17-20 ground fish regulations. Rockfish, lingcod, sheepshead and

whitefish are closed from January 1, 2019 to February 28, 2019. When the season opens all must be caught in less than 450 ft. of water. Then on page 25 starts the Ocean Fishing. Page 28 has the regulations for filleting a tuna on a vessel. Page 32, remember only ONE White Seabass from March 15th to June 15th. As most people know, you cannot take Giant Seabass (aka Black Seabass). Please release these great fish with a barbless hook with 2 lb. weight and help them get back down to the bottom. You can do this for rockfish too. See bottom right corner of page 20 for releasing these fish.

The first two tournaments of the 2019 season - the Artificials Tournament - April 6^{th} thru the 14^{th} followed by the All Species Tournament April 20^{th} thru 28^{th} . See Tournament Flyers on the following pages.

2018 Fiscal Report

For the year 2018, revenues of \$26,577 were up 8% over 2017. Although membership dues were even, the members spent a little more on raffles and more advertising was sold. The expenses for 2018 were also up 9.1%, with the major expenses all increasing. The largest increases were in the accounts: awards, trophy's and banners expense, banquet expenses, and the general member meeting food and rental expenses. The net revenues over expenses for 2018 was \$1,018 as compared to the 2017 amount \$134.

For the 2019 budget, we are hoping to again increase our advertising revenue from \$1,200 to \$2,500 as well as increase net membership by eight new members. The board of directors are working hard to make this happen, but we need the help of all members to make this happen. Our members have many contacts that can bring new revenue to our club, so our members

help in bring in more revenues will be paramount. Costs and expenses are expected to increase in 2019; and the Board of Directors are looking into ways to keep expenses flat. Even with the forecasted increase in revenues, we expect net revenues over expenses for 2019 to be approximately \$1,000.

For 2018 we donated \$1,800 to fishing and ocean conservation organizations. We would like to increase these amounts for 2019, but that will depend on the amount of revenue we bring in.

We thank our member for your participation in 2018 and look forward to even more participation in 2019.


