Fish Report by Chris Bailey

Fishing Report as of April 30, 2018

The recent winds and weather patterns have kept most coastal waters on the cooler side and off colored for most of April along the coast and local islands. Forecast calls for improving weather and warmer days beginning the first week of May. Expect to see the water temps continue to improve throughout the month.

The limited local fishing reports available have most boats still focusing on rockfish. Looking for improved conditions and fishing during the month of May. It's time to start looking offshore!

Full Moon April 29th, New Moon on May 15th and Full Moon on May 29th
Grunion run April 29th – May 2nd, May 15th – May 18th and May 29th – June 1st

Catalina: Limited Reports from Catalina due to recent weather. Possibility of Yellowtail and White Seabass being caught along Backside "V"'s to EE. Yellowtail along the Frontside /West End. We should start seeing Yellowtail and Calicos biting near the island.

Inshore/Coastal: Yellowtail, White Seabass and Halibut being caught on fin bait near kelp line. Salt Creek, Dana Point, San Mateo, San Onofre, Barn Kelp, La Jolla... Offshore Kelps starting to see Yellowtails on kelp paddies, some larger bonito also being seen.

Offshore: Yes, the rumors are true. Last week a couple ¾ Day boats out of San Diego came across some schools of Bluefin Tuna – mixed grades, from 30# “schoolies” to 100# models being seen and caught. These fish are moving north. Hopefully with the improving weather and water temps they will reach the SoCal waters soon.

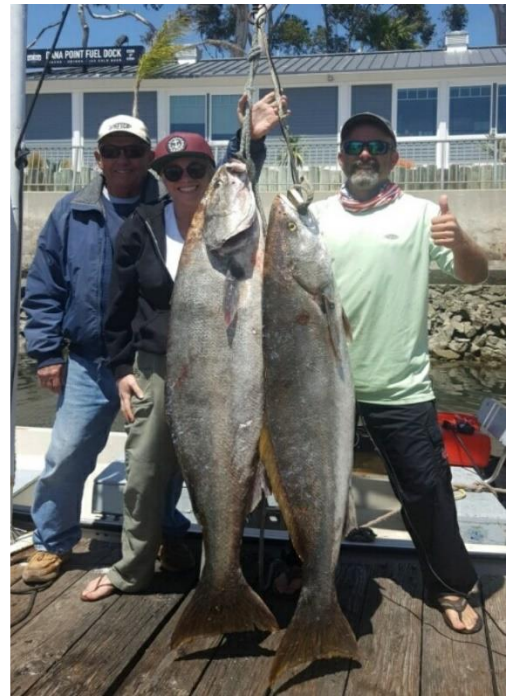
